- Refunds not permitted after pools have opened for the Summer season (June 6, 2026).

- All pools are handicap accessible

## OUTDOOR POOL CLOSING POLICIES

- If the predicted high temperature is 65 degrees or less, the pools will not open for that session.
- Pools close at 4:15 <sup>pm</sup> on July 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Lightning: Flash-to-bang method will be used. If the pool is closed for lightning, it will remain closed for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- If pools close due to weather or low attendance, there will be NO refunds/vouchers given.

**LIFEGUARD TRAINING CLASS: AGES 15+**

Participants must be 15 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of the course. All participants must contact the FDL-SD Aquatic Center at (920) 929-3536 to schedule your prerequisite skill tests prior to beginning of each class. Fee will be reimbursed on final paycheck of summer for participants who maintain employment by the FDL-SD Comm Ed & Rec Dept. **Location: FDL-SD Aquatic Center**

**Lifeguard Training Prerequisite Skills Tests** (to be completed prior to beginning of class)

**Skill Test 1:**

- Jump into the water and totally submerge, resurface then swim 150 yards using crawl, breast stroke or a combination of both. (Swimming on the back or side is permitted. Swim goggles are allowed)
- Maintain position at the surface of the water for 2 minutes by treading water using only the legs
- Swim 50 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both

**Skill Test 2:** *Complete within 1 minute, 40 seconds*

- Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. (The face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed)
- Surface dive (feet-first or head-first) to a depth of 7 - 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object.
- Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, holding the object at the surface with both hands and keeping the face out at or near the surface.
- Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

*If you would like to practice prior to being tested, please call the Aquatic Center at (920) 929-3536 and check for available open swim hours and let them know you are coming in to practice prior to testing.*

**LOW-MODERATE IMPACT AEROBICS:** This is a 45 minute workout in the large pool that includes a warm-up, aerobic activity, toning, and a cool-down.

**MODERATE - HIGH IMPACT AEROBICS:** This class is a 45 minute workout that includes a warm-up, 20-30 minutes of aerobic activity, toning, and cool-down.

**DEEP - DEEP END EXERCISE PROGRAM:** Flotation belts provide buoyancing, eliminating stress on the joints. This class includes cardiovascular conditioning and toning.

**DOWNTOWN TRAIL:** 1 mile paved trail parallels the FDL River & extends from Brooke St. south to Morris St. through downtown Fond du Lac.

**BROOKE STREET TRAIL:** Paved trail extending north to Lakeside Park & south to Dixie St., total of 1.5 miles long. This trail links with the Downtown Trail & will eventually link up with the Wild Goose State Park Trail.

**GREENWAY ARBORETUM:** Consists of 19 acres of natural habitat along the East branch of the Fond du Lac River. Access to the Greenway can be found behind the Salvation Army store on Pioneer Rd. The natural trail will lead you into the arboretum and loop back to starting point.

**LAKESIDE PARK TRAIL:** Over 2.5 miles of paved trail. Trail takes you through much of Lakeside Park with beautiful views of Lake Winnebago. New trail takes you across the Fond du Lac River to Lakeside Park West.

**STORYWALKS:** Discover picture book adventures as you walk through Hamilton and Lakeside Park by visiting the latest StoryWalks. StoryWalks encourage families to enjoy reading and the outdoors by posting a children's book – a page at a time – at intervals along a path. During the warm season, StoryWalks get a new story each month.
