

Playoff Rules and Regulations - 2022

1. Not all teams will make the playoffs - Leagues with 9 or less teams will have 4 teams make playoffs. Leagues with 10 or more teams will have 6 teams make playoffs.
2. The first tiebreaker for a playoff position will be head-to-head league win-loss record. If multiple teams are tied for a spot, the winning percentage amongst games played involving only the teams tied will determine playoff seed.
3. Teams tied for 1st place or the last playoff spot, that also tied head-to-head in league play, will play a game for their seed positions. Teams tied for any other playoff seeds after the other tiebreakers will be decided by a coin toss.
4. Higher seed is home team - except for Championship Game.
5. Championship Game – coin flip – one game determines the winner.
6. If games are rained out, the next game shall be played in the next available time slot. Times to be determined.
7. Each team must provide the umpire with a good game ball.
8. Any player ejected the last game of the season or from playoffs shall be suspended from his or her next playoff game in that league. If a team has no more playoff games, it will carry over to the next season's first league game. (All league suspensions will carry through playoffs.)
9. No protests are allowed after the final out of a game.
10. All League Rules will be used - except time limit. This includes the use of run-rules.

NO RUN RULE OR TIME LIMIT FOR CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES.
