

SAFETY GUIDELINES – ADULT SOFTBALL – FDL REC DEPT LEAGUE GAMES

With the lifting of the Safer at Home Order and the Badger Bounce Bank Plan, the Fond du Lac Recreation Department is moving forward with our Summer Adult Softball Leagues.

The rescinding of the order does not mean that Covid-19 is gone. Now more than ever we need to follow some guidelines in order to help slow down and prevent the spread of the virus. Please share the following information with all of your players and fans.

1. If you are sick, not feeling well, have a fever, etc. STAY HOME. Do NOT show up to play or watch.
2. Players and fans are asked to follow social distancing guidelines, with at least 6 feet whenever possible.
3. Teams should provide sanitizer for their players.
4. Teams should try to sanitize bats after each use or inning.
5. No shaking of hands before or after games.
6. No eating during games or sharing of beverages.
7. Teams will provide two softballs per game, one new and one used – try to sanitize balls between innings.
8. In order to follow the social distancing guidelines, equipment will not be allowed in dug-outs. Some players may need to be outside of the dug-outs on the fence line.
9. Face coverings; bandanas, scarfs, and homemade masks are recommended to be worn by players, fans, umpires, and coaches.

Note: As a reminder, it is everyone's responsibility to assist in decreasing the risks related to the Coronavirus. If positive cases would see an increase there is the possibility that the leagues would be canceled. Thanks everyone for the cooperation and assistance in making these leagues possible.
